Jean d'Alibert is one of the main actors of the Caunes Minervois village. He contributed to the economic expansion of the Languedoc region, in particular he restored the abbey and extended the vineyards of Minervois.

SOIL-CLIMATE

The vineyard is situated in the hills on the west side of the Aude area, where the freshness of the oceanic climate favours the aromatic evolution of the variety.

WINEMAKING TECHNIQUES

After de-stemming, winemaking is traditional with pumping over twice a day. Pressing takes place at the end of the second week. The wine is aged in tanks for 9 months, then bottled in Spring in order to maintain the aromas.

TASTING NOTES

Nice ruby colour. Elegant and complex nose, dominated by a nose of black fruits and cherries in brandy, with spicy notes. The mouth is wel balanced and harmonious, with a long finish.

FOOD PAIRINGS

Drink young, goes perfectly with delicatessen food, red meats and cheeses. After 2 years, will be ideal to accompany dishes in sauce.
